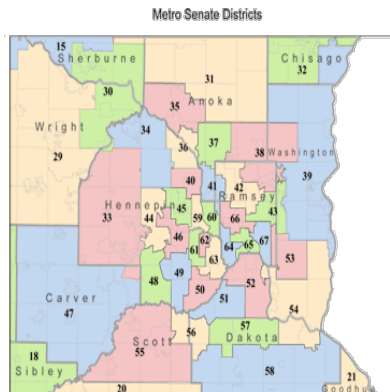
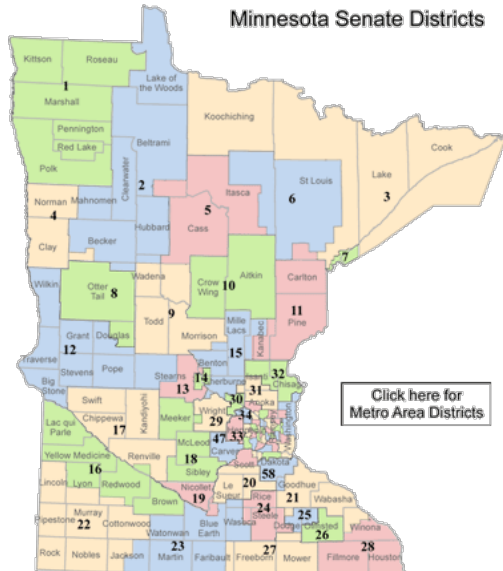


Minnesota State Senate

Minnesota is divided into 67 Senate Districts. Each Senate District elects 1 Senator for a 4-year term. A State Senator represents their district at the State Capitol in St. Paul. The last election for half of the State Senators was Tuesday November 4, 2014. The next election for the other half will be November 1st, 2016

The Boundaries of a Senate District:

- May contain an entire city or only parts of one. It may contain several cities or part of several. It may encompass an entire county or only part of one. It may also contain parts of several counties as well
- Cities are broken into precincts or wards which vary in size and are used to help organize votes and voting locations on Election Day

We are Senate District #35

- Cities in Senate District 35
 - Anoka, Ramsey, Andover (except the NE corner) and 3 northern Coon Rapids precincts
- Counties
 - Part of Anoka County
- Congressional Districts
 - CD 6 (Anoka, Ramsey and Andover)
 - CD3 (Coon Rapids)

Minnesota State House of Representatives

There are 134 House of Representatives in the State of Minnesota. Each Senate District is divided into two parts A & B. A elects one House Representative and B elects one House Representative for a 2-year term.
